June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021 NMSR Meeting: Dave Thomas and guests on "They're Ba-ack! Magnetic Water Conditioning and Other Pseudoscience Zombies".

The May meeting of NMSR started with a re-airing of a Larry Barker investigation from

2005, on so-called "magnetic water conditioners." Recent issues of the NM Marketplace flyer have featured full-page advertisements pitching these magnetic devices, paid for by local GMX dealer Larry Brown.

These ineffective devices were studied by NMSR in a project with KRQE TV's Larry

Barker. This collaboration involved NMSR's former treasurer, Nancy Shelton, who went incognito and wore a hidden camera to capture Brown's actual sales pitch.
