

God Unleashes Hell on Rio Rancho

Experts Say It's Payback for No Intelligent Design Being Taught As Science in Public Schools



Unconfirmed sources report that the city of Rio Rancho, New Mexico has been destroyed by massive floods. New Mexico State Department of Homeland Security officials are on the scene and indicate that the devastation of the once proud "City of Vision" is utterly complete.
